POST OPERATIVE CARE OF NAIL SURGERY

- 1. Keep dressing dry and on the foot until tomorrow morning
- 2. Remove the dressing and soak the foot in Epson salts twice a day beginning the morning after the nail or wart procedure. This should be done for 7 days unless otherwise instructed.
- 3. Epson Salts are mixed one tablespoon per pint of warm water.
- 4. Apply a small amount of antibiotic ointment like Neosporin or Triple Antibiotic after soaking and cover with a band-aid.
- 5. After 7 days apply peroxide to the toe twice a day. Discontinue the use of antibiotic ointment. Apply a dry bandaid during the day and leave the toe bare/uncovered at night while sleeping.
- 6. Return to the office for follow-up visit (usually two weeks after the procedure.)
- 7. Report any severe pain, redness, swelling or foul smelling discharge to the doctor.
